Wideband Aerial – Strongly Required

We recommend a wideband aerial for the best reception. We do not recommend using a loft aerial, as being inside means the signal strength is reduced.

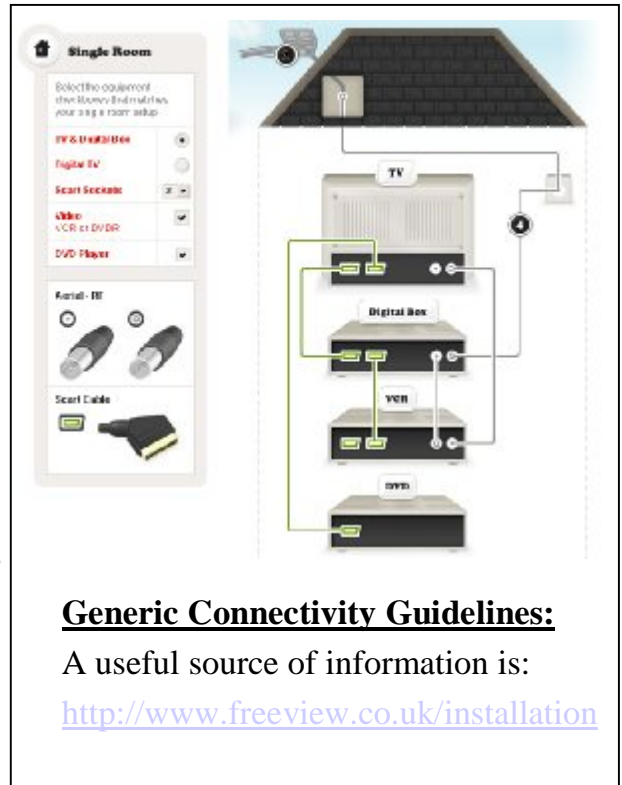

Reception:

Your reception depends on your location in relation to the transmitter and can affect how many channels you will receive. Bad weather and buildings can obstruct signals also.

Portable Aerials can I use one:

Some but only a few households might be able to use a set top aerial, but reception would still be unreliable and so we strongly recommend that you use a wideband rooftop aerial for good reception.

If you do not have access to a rooftop aerial eg you live in a flat and the aerial is the responsibility of the landlord – a set top aerial may be your only option.
